Such list, however, shall not be used for commercial purposes, or sold or distributed. <u>The Board shall vote on the validity of the request and make a determination to either, reject the request, permit a release of all, or part, of the membership list as requested.</u>

ARTICLE IX - MEETING AND VOTING

As Reads:

SECTION I - The annual meeting shall be held in June, not later than the 3rd week, at such location as determined by the Board. Notice shall be mailed or delivered at least seven (7) days prior to the meeting.

Change to Read:

SECTION I - The annual meeting shall be held in the spring at a date (between March and EOM June) and location as determined by the Board. Notice shall be mailed or delivered Members shall be notified at least seven (7 14) days prior to the meeting.
